

## **Prologue**

### **The Angel Said, “America Shall Be Saved!”<sup>i</sup>**

(From a Dutch Sheets Meeting in Washington, DC, on 2-22-18)

At the end of a gathering of Christians in Washington, DC, on February 22, 2018, I (Dutch Sheets) shared a dream that God gave to a lady a week before the gathering. The context of the dream was at the end of the gathering, which she attended.

#### **The Dream**

In the dream, this lady, who had attended the gathering, left with some friends of hers and walked out on the street in Washington, DC. She saw an angel and she could tell that he was on a mission going somewhere. He had a scroll in his hand.

So, she and her friends decided to follow the angel. The angel walked from the Dutch Sheets’ gathering to the Capitol. They followed the angel into the Capitol into a big meeting hall: the place where the President delivers the “State of the Union” address and entered the House chamber – the chamber for the House of Representatives.

## 2. Prayer of Rededication

Dear Heavenly Father,

I rededicate my life to you today, in Jesus' name. I repent for any sins that I have committed and ask you to forgive me. I turn away from them now. Wash my sins away with your precious blood. Make me whiter than snow. Give me a clean slate today. I renounce the works of the Devil. The Devil is not my lord. I reaffirm that you are my Lord and Savior. I will serve you, Jesus, for the rest of my life. Fill me now, Heavenly Father, with your Holy Spirit and your healing power. Make me the kind of person you want me to be. Help me fulfill my divine destiny and purpose upon the earth. And when it is time for me to die, take me to Heaven, Jesus, to live with you forever. I pray this prayer to the Father, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Eph 1:3-8: *"<sup>3</sup> Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,  
<sup>4</sup>just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,  
<sup>5</sup>having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,  
<sup>6</sup>to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.  
<sup>7</sup>In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace  
<sup>8</sup>which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence..."*

Eph 2:4-10: *"<sup>4</sup> But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,  
<sup>5</sup>even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),  
<sup>6</sup>and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places (third heaven) in Christ Jesus,  
<sup>7</sup>that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.  
<sup>8</sup>For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,  
<sup>9</sup>not of works, lest anyone should boast.  
<sup>10</sup>For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."*

From these passages in the Bible, since you have rededicated your life to Jesus, you can be confident about the following truths:

1--God chose you before the foundation of the world.

2--You are accepted in the Beloved (by Jesus).

3--God has raised you up to sit together with Jesus in heavenly places (the third heaven).

4--Therefore, you are positionally higher than Satan, who is the prince of the power of the air (second heaven) because of what Jesus did on the cross for you: to wit, died for your sins.

5--Jesus has **won the war** for you and defeated the Devil. Now you must submit to God's commandments in the Bible, and **enforce Satan's defeat in your own life**, knowing that the battle is the Lord's!

6--Your job is to kick the Devil out of your life by resisting him (James 4:7) with "faith-filled words" from the Bible, and overcome the flesh (self-will) and not conform to the world's standards, but put your mind on things above, and not on the earth.

7--God has created you for good works, and as you allow Jesus to conform you more and more to his holy character by repenting of sin and receiving cleansing and healing, you will perform these good works, not in your own strength, but with the assistance of His Holy Spirit working through you.

Phil 4:13: *"<sup>13</sup> I can do all things through Christ (Jesus and His anointing) who strengthens me."*

Eph 2:10: *"<sup>10</sup> For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."*
